

Interview Questions

Always Ask:

- What is your name?
- What 4-H Project are you bringing to show me today?

General Questions:

- Ask 2-3 general open-ended questions. You can create your own or choose from the list below.
 - Tell me about your 4-H Project.
 - What did you like *most* about this project?
 - What did you like *least* about this project?
 - What made you interested in this project?
 - What was the something you learned from this project?
 - Who was your project helper?
 - Would you recommend this project to others? Why or why not?
 - Do you have anything else you want me to know about your project?
 - Can you show me your favorite activity you completed in the project book?

Project Specific Questions:

- Ask 1-2 questions related specifically to their project (see questions in folder) make sure to use appropriate questions based on the child's age and experience level.

General 4-H Knowledge:

- If you have time, you may also use these general 4-H knowledge questions.
 - Do you know what one of the four H's stands for in our logo?
 - ✓ *Head, Heart, Hands, or Health*
 - What is the 4-H Motto?
 - ✓ *"To make the best Better"*
