Congratulations on making through another 4-H Enrollment Season! (Well, almost). We have a few updates and important reminders.

Did you Enroll Yourself?

Volunteers need to enroll, too and we have lots of inactive volunteer profiles (almost ?!!). Please enroll online or contact the office to get a paper form if you cannot enroll online. You can still get into the system to enroll online (but we are not approving members enrolled after the deadline as traditional, competitive members).

Deadline for ALL Volunteer Training & Enrollments is April 15th.

This is the last reminder we are sending for enrollments, training and repeat BCI checks. Volunteers who have not completed these items will no longer be active volunteers. Re-activating a volunteer is a process similar to new volunteer screening. If there is a reason you are having a hard time doing this, please contact us. If you have decided to no longer volunteer, please let us know. We know that some of you have been for BCI's and are waiting on the university to approve them. We have invoices that show who went in February and March unless you went to another location. You will not be archived if you went to CASA for an appointment.

Enrollment Appointment Reminder

Please remember that you need to make an appointment to bring your enrollment paperwork and payment. We are not permitted to have walk-in customers for as long as our county is red on the Ohio health map. We also need to track appointments to meet Health Department regulations. Our counselor team has been busy with training this month. They are building their team, learning about child development, and practicing skills needed to lead younger youth at whatever type of program option we have and decide. We have been told to expect more information and definitive answers by April 15th.
